If the Billed Usage and Interval Data do not match: 1) any missing intervals in the Interval Data will first be determined using market information for your usage profile, then these intervals will be proportionately adjusted so the sum of all intervals equal the Billed Usage provided by the TDU; or 2) if there is no missing interval information, each interval of the Interval Data will be proportionately adjusted so the sum of all intervals equal the Billed Usage provided by the TDU.

The TDU monthly charges and consumption charges are charges from the transmission and distribution service provider and are passed through without mark-up.
